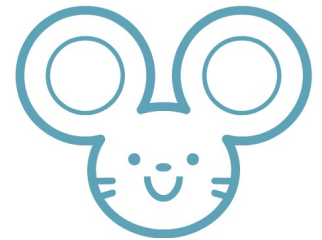







Example

If you give a Mouse a Cookie
by Laura Numeroff

-  **P**rompt your child ← *What do you think the mouse will do next?*
-  **E**valuate their response ← *Yes, I think he will want another cookie.*
-  **E**xpand on their response ← *Why did he want another cookie?*
-  **R**epeat the prompt ← *That mouse wanted a cookie to go with the milk.*

Types of prompts: CROWD



-  **C**ompletion ← *He's going to ask for a glass of _____!*
-  **R**ecall ← *What does the mouse ask for next?*
-  **O**pen-ended ← *What do you see on this page?*
-  **W**hat, where, when, why, how ← *How does the mouse feel when he looks in the mirror?*
-  **D**istancing ← *Did you hang your picture on the refrigerator?*
